

Year 10 Food & Drink Project

Prepare a morning/afternoon tea party

Language topic – Food and Drink, shopping for food, understanding recipes, invitations, understanding French currency

Grammar: future tense with “aller”, imperatives, transactional language

- what is the reason for the event (try to make it culturally significant),
- plan what you are going to serve,
- find a French recipe www.recettesfaciles.net (preferably something that is a French speciality) or just do a search for recettes françaises.
- make shopping list, go online to www.intermarche.com or another French supermarket, find out how much it will all cost
- imagine the conversation you might have in a shop to buy the food
- Design an invitation - give time and date, what you would like people to bring, dress code?
- Write a daily blog saying what you are doing to prepare for your tea party
- follow the recipe you have chosen and serve it at the morning/afternoon tea!

Optional: You could also include clothes you are going to wear, descriptions of the people you have invited, a description of the venue and directions on how to get there.

Your Blog can be done using the Uspace Blog on the Ultranet. You will still need to write it in a Word Document in order to upload it. You can include photos and pictures. Photos of you cooking would be great to see!

You can use the Message box to “talk” to other people in your group – you could even have a go at “talking” in French!

Upload all your documents into your Portfolio on uSpace
