Upon finishing this course you will be able to:

- Communicate, compare and contrast habits and routines (eg: asking and answering questions about school timetables)
- Communicate about events and where they take place (eg: arranging an outing with your friends on the phone)
- Give and follow directions (eg: following written directions to the local pool)
- Communicate compare and contrast how people travel (eg: designing a poster to use alternative transports to go to school. work)
- Offer, ask for, accept and decline invitations and suggestions (eg: organizing items for a birthday party)
- Communicate about plans for the immediate future (eg: listing what you'll do at the week end)
- Communicate about obligations and responsibilities (eg: talking about the house chores you have to do)
- Give and seek permission (eg: role playing the situation when a teenager asks his/her parent to go to a late party)
- Communicate about the quality, quantity and cost of things (eg: looking up Amazon.fr on Internet and comparing with prices in New Zealand)
